Bookings and Communication -

- Bookings and payments are to be made through Arbor
- Notify absences to the school office.
- Communication from After School Club will be via email and/or Arbor.



Cost and Timings -

- 3.25pm - 4.30pm £8 (Fee includes a light healthy snack)
- 4.30pm - 6pm £12 (Fee includes a light tea)
- 3.25pm - 6pm £18 (Fee includes both snacks)
- Fees must be paid in advance via Arbor.
- We are able to accept Childcare Vouchers - please notify Miss Maton or the School Business Manager of your voucher provider.
- Children will be dropped off to the After School Club by a staff member.
- Activities available will include free choice and supported activities, a variety of games, crafts and access to the outdoors (weather dependent).



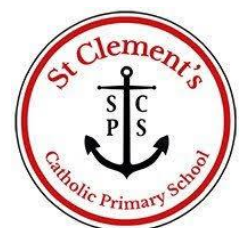
Food Provision -

 - Light tea will include baked beans on toast, sandwiches, pasta, hotdogs etc
