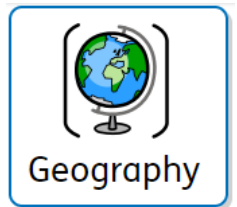




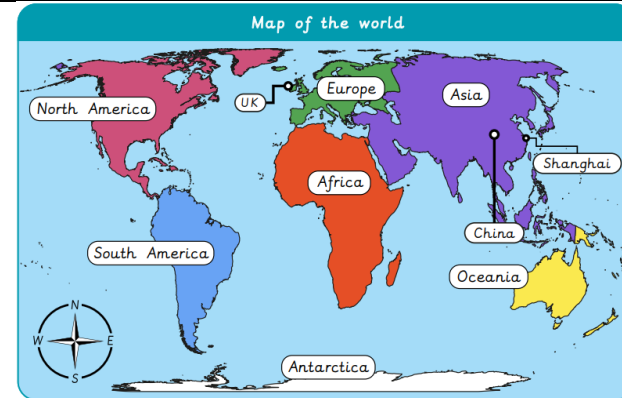

continent	A large land mass.	
human feature	A large feature that was built by people, such as a road, bridge or town.	
physical feature	A landform that occurs naturally on Earth, such as a river, hill or beach.	
directional language	Words that tell you where something is located in relation to something else, e.g. near, far, next to, behind, etc.	
country	A land or nation with its own government.	
map	A picture of a place, drawn from above.	
symbol	A mark that represents a feature on a map.	
key	A list that explains what the symbols on a map mean.
